
Jesus Calls Disciples

When they pushed out to the deep water and let down their nets, so many fish swam into their nets that their nets started to break!




They filled both of the boats with so many fish that the boats started to sink.






As Nathanael was walking toward Jesus, Jesus shouted, "Look a true Israelite who doesn't lie and trick people!"
