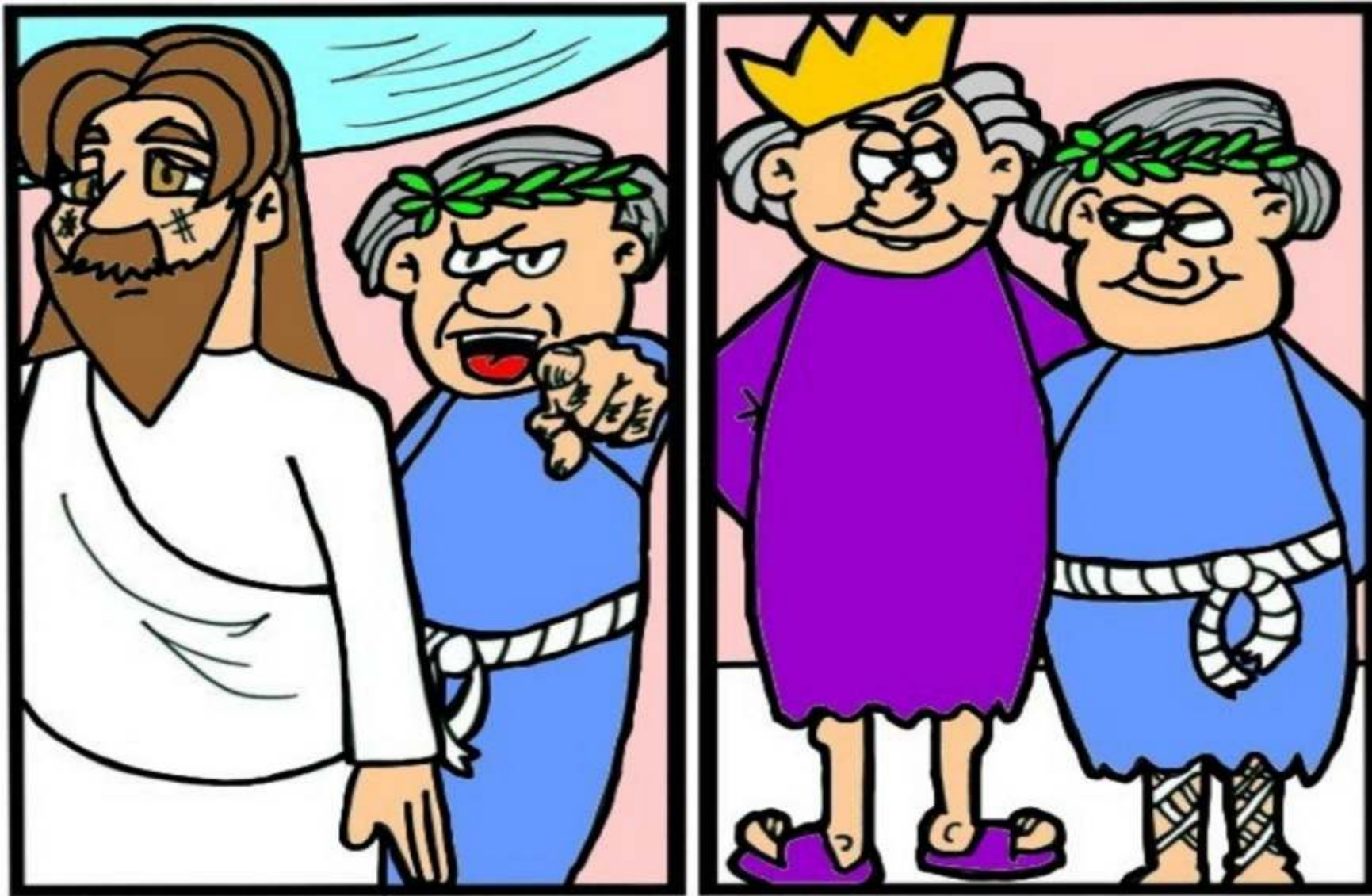

They blindfolded him, spit on his face and beat him. "Use your prophet powers and tell us who hit you," they said as they made fun of him.



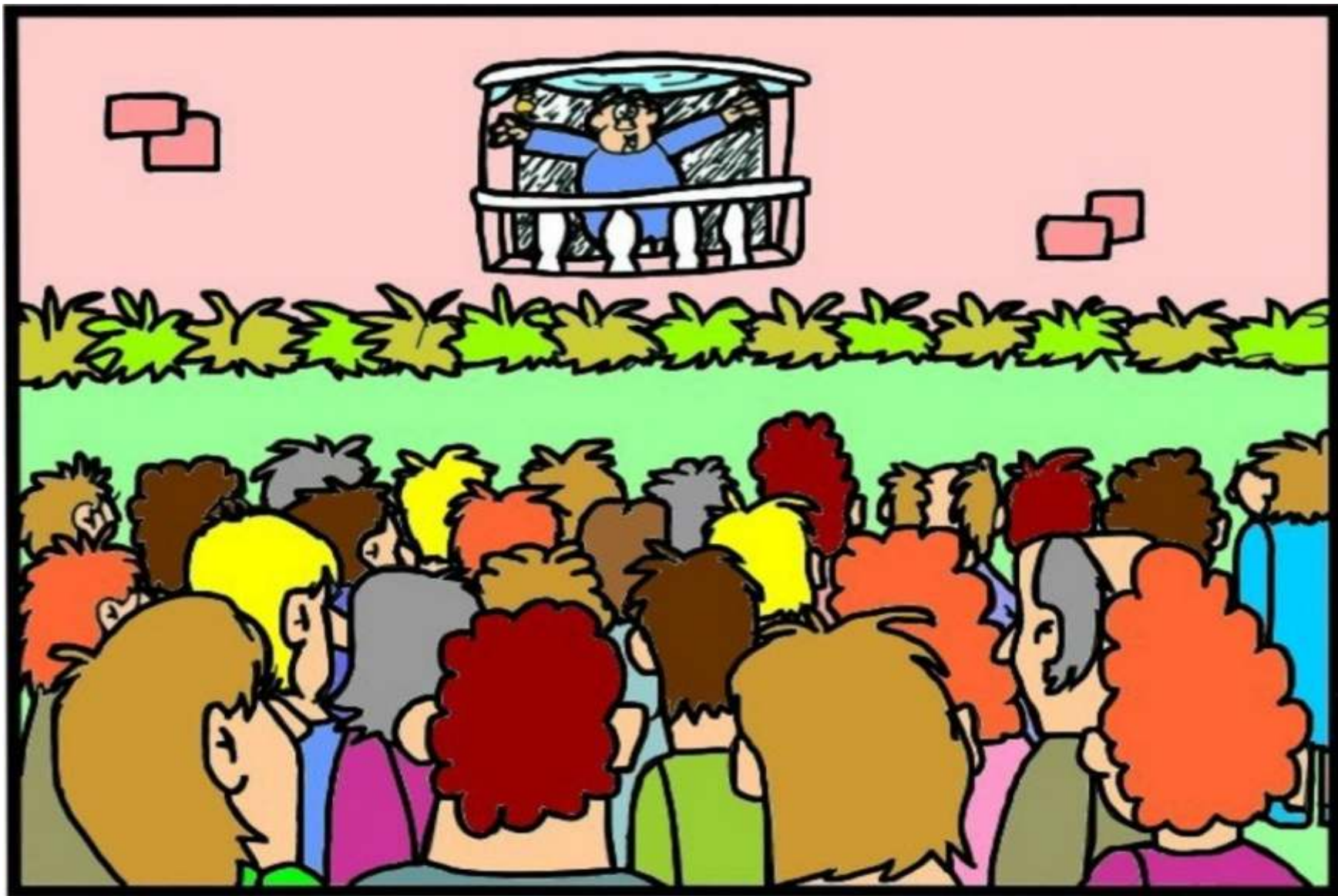
